TASTING NOTES

Ulysses 2013 delivers savory notes of woodland strawberries and jasmine. Luminous and tightly woven, the wine seizes the palate with grip and exuberance.

VINTAGE SUMMARY

2013 was characterized by early winter rains followed by a very dry spring and a consistently warm summer/early fall. Only 6.4 inches of rainfall were recorded from January to June (versus 17.7 inches average).

Low water reserves in the soil limited vine growth.

While average temperatures remained warm throughout spring and summer, no heat spikes were recorded in July, August or September.
